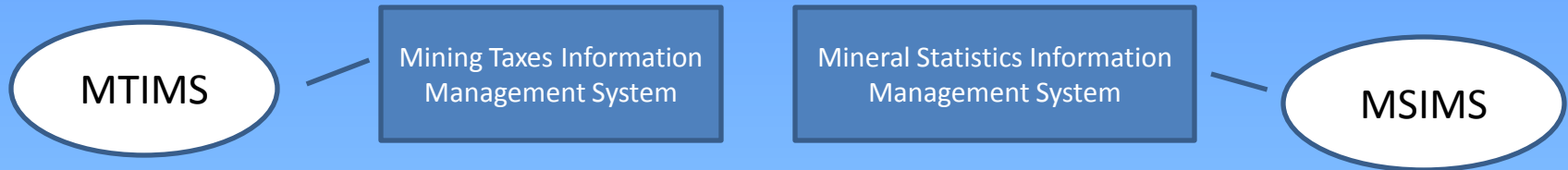

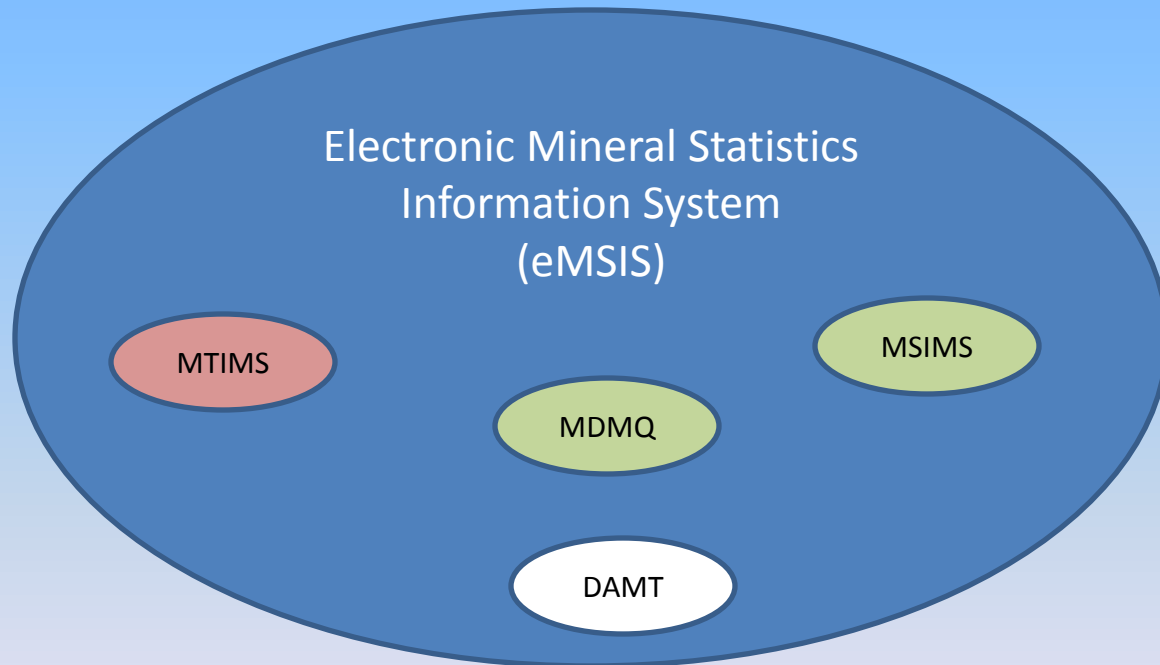

Last week of September	MTIMS Integration <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Server setting in preparation for the integration process➤ MTIMS was integrated to the electronic Mineral Statistics Information System (eMSIS)➤ Testing of the newly integrated system
Second week of October	

OUTPUT:

- New URL address (a sub domain of the mgb.gov.ph) has been assigned to the system data entry and reports generation (<http://eMSIS.mgb.gov.ph> for data entry and <http://reports.mgb.gov.ph> for report generation)
- Consolidation of user access of the two systems
- Mining Project/Mining Company entry in MTIMS has been eliminated and make use of the available information from the MDMQ
- MTIMS has been tested and deployed for live operation

OUTPUT:

- Local internet connection has been tested and problems in accessing the system using the local service provider has been noted
- MTIMS regional users were able to access the system and encoded the latest Revenues Collected by the MGB and Fees and Charges Collected by the LGUs
- Minor problems and recommendations from the end-user has been noted
